The conference will be conducted in English.

CONFERENCE COSTS

The conference fee is 290Euro/\$375U.S. per person. This fee includes lodging for 4 nights in a shared double room, meals for 4 days, dinner cruise excursion, invitation letter for visa, airport transfers, and all the conference materials. The fee also includes a copy of the proceedings to be published and mailed after the conference. A single room and/or extra nights lodging can be arranged for an extra fee. Transportation to/from Moscow is not included in the conference fee.
