

*Transportation Guide: IAPCHE Taipei 2008*

March 2008

Dear conference participant,

Welcome to Taipei. Though Taipei is an international metropolitan area, IAPCHE Taipei 08 hosting committee has decided to provide as much transportation service as our resources allow.

For people arriving on May 3<sup>rd</sup> and leaving on May 7<sup>th</sup>, the conference provides free bus services to and from the airport. See option 3 in the table below. In this case, there will be helpers who will hold up “IAPCHE” signs at your exit gate and lead you to the bus. If you need Taiwanese cash for shopping and other purposes, you could exchange your US dollars to Taiwanese dollars at the conference site.

However, if you have a different itinerary, transportation should not be a problem either. The airport staff members, people in the airport and even the taxi drivers understand some English. We have listed two options (1 and 2 below) for you to consider. We also provide you with bilingual slips (attached below) for your usage in case you need to communicate with people who do not quite understand English. Please make a print out and bring it along with you. The slip to be given to the taxi drivers would especially be helpful. If you ride a taxi from the airport (option 2) which we strongly recommend, please make sure you use official airport taxi services for better quality. There will be a line-up for taxis on the curb side. You will also need to make some currency exchanges at the airport for your transportation needs.
